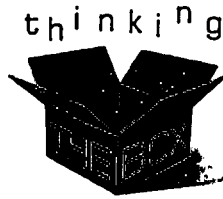


What did you learn about “50 strategies teaching with second language

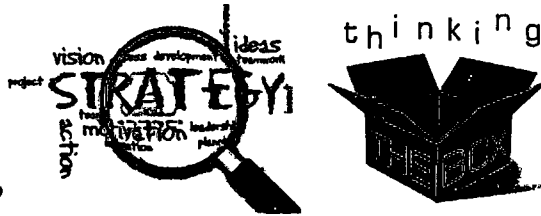

2. Put yourself in their place!



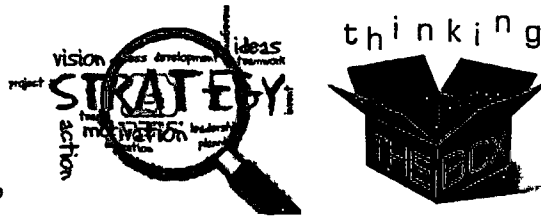

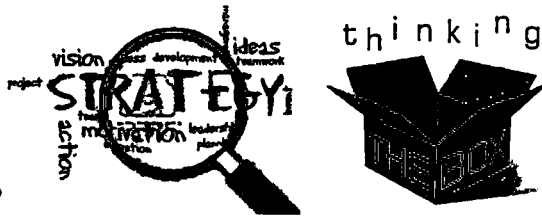

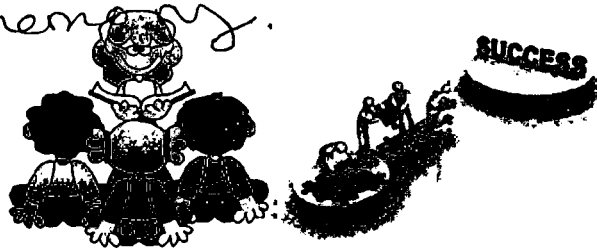
What did you learn about “50 strategies teaching with second language

2. Students learn by making associations/connections to cement words into memory.



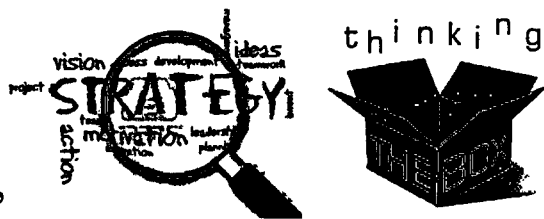

2. Students learn better if the pace of the class moves quickly



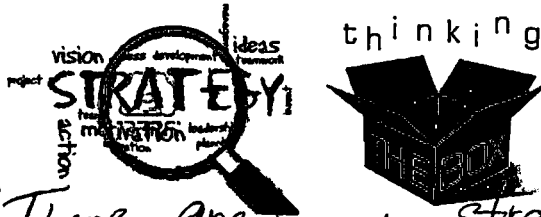

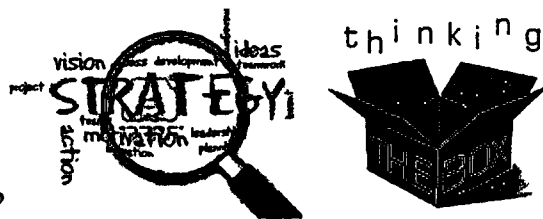
